# Intercession

## Matthew 21:13

**“It is Written My house shall be called a house of prayer.”**

## 2 Chronicles 7:14

**“If my people who are called by my name will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and heal their land.”**

## Ezekiel 22:30

**“So I sought for a man among them who would make a wall, and stand in the gap before me on behalf of the land, that I should not destroy it, but I found none.”**

## Hebrews 7:25

**Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.”**

# **Foundations of Intercessory Prayer**

1. **“It is written, My house shall be called a house of prayer.” (Matthew 21:13)**

2. **Pray the Word of God**

**A. Ephesians 6:17-18**

And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God; 18 praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints

**B. 1 John 5:14-15**

Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. 15 And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.

3. **Establish a lawful court case**

**A. God is the judge**

**Hebrews 12:23**

23 to the general assembly and church of the firstborn who are registered in heaven, to God the Judge of all, to the spirits of just men made perfect,

**B. Jesus is their advocate (defense attorney)**

**1 John 2:1-2**

My little children, these things I write to you, so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. 2 And He Himself is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the whole world.

**C. The devil is the Prosecutor**

**Revelation 12:10-12**

10 Then I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, "Now salvation, and

strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ have come, for the accuser of our brethren, who accused them before our God day and night, has been cast down. 11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death. 12 Therefore rejoice, O heavens, and you who dwell in them! Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and the sea! For the devil has come down to you, having great wrath, because he knows that he has a short time."

#### **D. A case must be based on Law (the Covenant)**

##### **Romans 8:2**

2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.

#### **E. The witness is the Blood**

##### **Hebrews 8:6**

6 But now He has obtained a more excellent ministry, inasmuch as He is also Mediator of a better covenant, which was established on better promises.

##### **Hebrews 12:24**

24 to Jesus the Mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling that speaks better things than that of Abel.

### **4. Stand your ground**

#### **Exodus 32:6-14**

6 Then they rose early on the next day, offered burnt offerings, and brought peace offerings; and the people sat down to eat and drink, and rose up to play. 7 And the LORD said to Moses, "Go, get down! For your people whom you brought out of the land of Egypt have corrupted themselves. 8 They have turned aside quickly out of the way which I commanded them. They have made themselves a molded calf, and worshiped it and sacrificed to it, and said, 'This is your god, O Israel, that brought you out of the land of Egypt!'" 9 And the LORD said to Moses, "I have seen this people, and indeed it is a stiff-necked people! 10 Now therefore, let Me alone, that My wrath may burn hot against them and I may consume them. And I will make of you a great nation." 11 Then Moses pleaded with

the LORD his God, and said: "LORD, why does Your wrath burn hot against Your people whom You have brought out of the land of Egypt with great power and with a mighty hand? 12 Why should the Egyptians speak, and say, 'He brought them out to harm them, to kill them in the mountains, and to consume them from the face of the earth'? Turn from Your fierce wrath, and relent from this harm to Your people. 13 Remember Abraham, Isaac, and Israel, Your servants, to whom You swore by Your own self, and said to them, 'I will multiply your descendants as the stars of heaven; and all this land that I have spoken of I give to your descendants, and they shall inherit it forever.'" 14 So the LORD relented from the harm which He said He would do to His people.

# **Prayer Preparation**

## **1. Putting on the whole armor of God**

### **Ephesians 6:10-18**

Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. 11 Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. 12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. 13 Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. 14 Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness, 15 and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace; 16 above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. 17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God; 18 praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints

## **2. Apply the Blood of the Covenant to the doorposts of our lives**

### **A. Apply the Blood**

#### **Exodus 12:7**

7 And they shall take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and on the lintel of the houses where they eat it.

### **B. Apply the Blood with your mouth over these areas:**

#### **Psalms 107:2**

Let the redeemed of the LORD say so, Whom He has redeemed from the hand of the enemy.

- 1. Family**
- 2. Work**
- 3. Church**
- 4. Everything important**

## **Sample Blood application:**

I cover my home with the Blood of Jesus to protect my family and possessions from any influence, Satan, that you or your evil spirits would try to exert. I bring to bear the power of the Blood of Jesus Christ to bind you. Satan, I remind you that whatever is bound on earth is bound in heaven.

### **C. Hold the Blood until victory comes.**

#### **1 Peter 5:8, 9a**

8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour. 9 Resist him, steadfast in the faith

1. Resist him whether a long time or short, until he goes, for he must go.
2. Speak to the mountain and never relax until victory comes
3. Continue to meet Satan with the Blood and never release until he flees.

#### **James 4:7**

7 Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you

#### **Galatians 6:9**

9 And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart.

**We, as a prayer group, cannot quit too soon!**

# Intercessory Prayer for the Lost

## A. The will of God for the Lost:

### **John 3:16-17**

16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

### **2 Corinthians 5:20**

19 that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation.

### **Psalms 2:7-8**

7 "I will declare the decree: The LORD has said to Me, 'You are My Son, Today I have begotten You. 8 Ask of Me, and I will give You The nations for Your inheritance, And the ends of the earth for Your possession.

### **1 Timothy 4:10-11**

10 For to this end we both labor and suffer reproach, because we trust in the living God, who is the Savior of all men, especially of those who believe.

### **2 Peter 3:9**

9 The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.

### **Luke 23:34**

4 Then Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do."

### **John 20:20-23**

20 When He had said this, He showed them His hands and His side. Then the disciples were glad when they saw the Lord. 21 So Jesus

said to them again, "Peace to you! As the Father has sent Me, I also send you." 22 And when He had said this, He breathed on them, and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. 23 If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained."

### **2 Timothy 2:24-26**

25 in humility correcting those who are in opposition, if God perhaps will grant them repentance, so that they may know the truth, 26 and that they may come to their senses and escape the snare of the devil, having been taken captive by him to do his will.

### **John 6:44-46**

44 No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and I will raise him up at the last day. 45 It is written in the prophets, 'And they shall all be taught by God.' Therefore everyone who has heard and learned from the Father comes to Me.

### **John 4:35-38**

35 Do you not say, 'There are still four months and then comes the harvest'? Behold, I say to you, lift up your eyes and look at the fields, for they are already white for harvest! 36 And he who reaps receives wages, and gathers fruit for eternal life, that both he who sows and he who reaps may rejoice together. 37 For in this the saying is true: 'One sows and another reaps.' 38 I sent you to reap that for which you have not labored; others have labored, and you have entered into their labors."

### **Matthew 9:37-38**

37 Then He said to His disciples, "The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few. 38 Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest."

### **Acts 26:17-18**

17 I will deliver you from the Jewish people, as well as from the Gentiles, to whom I now send you, 18 to open their eyes, in order to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who are sanctified by faith in Me.'

### **1 Timothy 2:1-6,8**

Therefore I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men, 2 for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence. 3 For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, 4 who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth. 5 For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus, 6 who gave Himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time. 8 I desire therefore that the men pray everywhere, lifting up holy hands, without wrath and doubting;

### **Isaiah 53:6,10,11**

All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned, every one, to his own way; and the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all. 10 Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise Him; He has put Him to grief. When You make His soul an offering for sin, He shall see His seed, He shall prolong His days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in His hand. 11 He shall see the labor of His soul, and be satisfied. By His knowledge My righteous Servant shall justify many, for He shall bear their iniquities.

### **1 John 3:8**

8 He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.

## **4. The Love of God for the Lost**

### **A. Matthew 5:43-48**

"You have heard that it was said, 'You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy.' 44 But I say to you, love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you, 45 that you may be sons of your Father in heaven; for He makes His sun rise on the evil and on the good, and sends rain on the just and on the unjust.

46 For if you love those who love you, what reward have you? Do not even the tax collectors do the same? 47 And if you greet your brethren only, what do you do more than others? Do not even the tax collectors do so? 48 Therefore you shall be perfect, just as your Father in heaven is perfect.

**B. Luke 6:35-36**

35 But love your enemies, do good, and lend, hoping for nothing in return; and your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High. For He is kind to the unthankful and evil. 36 Therefore be merciful, just as your Father also is merciful.

**C. Our intercession is to break the bondage that Satan has over the minds of men.**

**D. 2 Corinthians 10:3-5**

3 For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. 4 For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, 5 casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ ***When the sinner sees God the way He is, without deception, he will accept the Lord.***

**E. Matthew 16:17-19**

17 Jesus answered and said to him, "Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jonah, for flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but My Father who is in heaven. 18 And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it.

**5. Our Adversary (the devil) opposes the will of God**

**A. We must break the power of the devil over man.**

**B. 2 Corinthians 4:3-5**

3 But even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing, 4 whose minds the god of this age has blinded, who do not believe, lest the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is

the image of God, should shine on them.

### **C. Ephesians 6:10-12**

Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. 11 Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. 12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places.

### **D. 1 John 5:19**

19 We know that we are of God, and the whole world lies under the sway of the wicked one.

### **E. Dan 10:2-3, 5-7,10-14**

2 In those days I, Daniel, was mourning three full weeks. 3 I ate no pleasant food, no meat or wine came into my mouth, nor did I anoint myself at all, till three whole weeks were fulfilled.

5 I lifted my eyes and looked, and behold, a certain man clothed in linen, whose waist was girded with gold of Uphaz! 6 His body was like beryl, his face like the appearance of lightning, his eyes like torches of fire, his arms and feet like burnished bronze in color, and the sound of his words like the voice of a multitude. 7 And I, Daniel, alone saw the vision, for the men who were with me did not see the vision; but a great terror fell upon them, so that they fled to hide themselves.

10 Suddenly, a hand touched me, which made me tremble on my knees and on the palms of my hands. 11 And he said to me, "O Daniel, man greatly beloved, understand the words that I speak to you, and stand upright, for I have now been sent to you." While he was speaking this word to me, I stood trembling. 12 Then he said to me, "Do not fear, Daniel, for from the first day that you set your heart to understand, and to humble yourself before your God, your words were heard; and I have come because of your words. 13 But the prince of the kingdom of Persia withstood me twenty-one days; and behold, Michael, one of the chief princes, came to help me, for I had been left alone there with the kings of Persia. 14 Now I have come to make you understand what will happen to your people in the latter days, for the vision refers to many days yet to come."

## **F. The devil is a thief and he primarily steals people from God**

### **John 10:10**

10 The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

## **G. Ephesians 2:1-6**

And you He made alive, who were dead in trespasses and sins, 2 in which you once walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience, 3 among whom also we all once conducted ourselves in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, just as the others. 4 But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, 5 even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), 6 and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus,

## **H. Titus 3:3-6**

4 But when the kindness and the love of God our Savior toward man appeared, 5 not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit, 6 whom He poured out on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Savior,

## **I. Hebrews 4:16**

16 Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

## **6. Praying the will of God for the Lost & Believers**

### **A. We have the authority to intercede for the lost, because:**

1. "If we pray according to your will, You hear us and if we know that you hear us, we know we have the petitions we asked for. (1 John 5:14-15 paraphrased)
2. We know that it is Your will that the lost come to the knowledge of their salvation.

## **Prayer for the lost**

Satan, we announce to you today that we have been given all authority to break your stronghold over the minds of those who you keep in darkness through unbelief. We recognize that all the requirements for salvation were satisfied in Jesus Christ, "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten son that whosoever would believe on Him would be saved" (John 3:16). "God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them and has committed to His church (us) the word of reconciliation. Satan, God already saved, paid the price for every man 2,000 years ago. He has already given Jesus "The nations for His inheritance" (Psalm 1:7). God's will is that "not any man should perish" (2 Peter 3:9), and we know "if we pray according to God's will He hears us and grants the petitions we ask" (1 John 5:14-15), and the Holy Spirit exhorts us that supplications, prayers, intercessions and giving of thanks be made for all men." (1 Timothy 2:1) Father God we recognize that "No man can come to Jesus unless the Father draws him" (John 6:44). Father, Jesus said, "Do you not say there are still four months until the harvest, but I say lift up your eyes and look at the fields, for they are already white for harvest." (John 4:35) For the harvest is truly plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore I pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest. (Matthew 9:37-38) Father God, I ask you to forgive the lost and ignorant as Jesus did on the cross (Luke 23:34). "Grant them repentance, that they may escape the snare of the devil" (2 Timothy 2:25-26) Father "we have chosen to remit and not retain our neighbors' sin" (John 20:23).

Satan, "God desires that all men be saved" (1 Timothy 2:4) so I command you to "loose the minds of lost men and cease from your actions of blinding them to the truth of their complete deliverance" (2 Corinthians 4:4) through the blood sacrifice of our Lord Jesus Christ. Satan, I hold the Blood of the Covenant, which is the price paid for the promises of our

inheritance (Hebrews 9 & 2 Peter) against you!

Father, I want to thank you for the victory of many salvations in Costa Mesa. I want to thank you that you are “opening the eyes of the lost (as the devil is loosed), turning them from darkness to light and from the power of Satan to God” (Acts 26:18). Father, we recognize that we “wrestle not against flesh and blood” (Ephesians 6:12) and we take our authority over our adversary knowing that “whatever we bind on earth is bound in heaven and whatever we loose on earth is loosed in heaven” (Matthew 16:19). Satan, loose the people of Costa Mesa, in Jesus Name, AMEN!

## **Prayer for Believers**

Father God, “we take the Sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God and we pray with all prayer and supplication for all the saints: (Ephesians 6:17, 18), knowing that we are “praying according to your will (for your Word is your will) and You hear us and grant our petitions” (1 John 5:14, 15).

### **Ephesians 1:16-23**

16 do not cease to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers: 17 that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, 18 the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, 19 and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power 20 which He worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, 21 far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come. 22 And He put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be head over all things to the church, 23 which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all.

### **Ephesians 3:14-21**

14 For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, 15 from whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, 16 that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man, 17 that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, 18 may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height 19 to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God. 20 Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us, 21 to Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen.

Father, I pray for the believers or Costa Mesa, that we “would be strong in the Lord and the power of His might, putting on the whole armor of God that we would be able to stand against the wiles of the devil, having a revelation that we do not wrestle against flesh and blood but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in heavenly places” (Eph 6:10-12)

### **Philippians 1:9-11**

9 And this I pray, that your love may abound still more and more in knowledge and all discernment, 10 that you may approve the things that are excellent, that you may be sincere and without offense till the day of Christ, 11 being filled with the fruits of righteousness which are by Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.

### **Philippians 3:10-14**

10 that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death, 11 if, by any means, I may attain to the resurrection from the dead. Not that I have already attained, or am already perfected; but I press on, that I may lay hold of that for which Christ Jesus has also laid hold of me. 13 Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended; but one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead, 14 I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.

### **Colossians 1:9-14**

9 For this reason we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; 10 that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; 11 strengthened with all might, according to His glorious power, for all patience and longsuffering with joy; 12 giving thanks to the Father who has qualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light. 13 He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love, 14 in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.

### **Hebrews 13:20-21**

20 Now may the God of peace who brought up our Lord Jesus from the dead, that great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, 21 make you complete in every good work to do His will, working in you what is well pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory forever and ever. Amen.

“We call those things that be not as though they are” (Romans 4:17)...

## **7. Prayer for the Children of the church (Believers)**

**A. It is God’s will that our Children be saved because of our salvation. Our children are part of our spiritual inheritance:**

### **Acts 2:38-39**

38 Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. 39 For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call."

### **Deuteronomy 7:9**

9 "Therefore know that the LORD your God, He is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and mercy for a thousand generations with those who love Him and keep His commandments

### **1 Corinthians 7:14**

14 For the unbelieving husband is sanctified by the wife, and the unbelieving wife is sanctified by the husband; otherwise your children would be unclean, but now they are holy.

### **Psalms 112:1-3**

Praise the LORD! Blessed is the man who fears the LORD, Who delights greatly in His commandments. 2 His descendants will be mighty on earth; The generation of the upright will be blessed. 3 Wealth and riches will be in his house, and his righteousness endures forever.

### **Acts 16:31-32**

31 So they said, "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household."

## **Noah's Family Saved**

### **Gen 7:1**

Then the LORD said to Noah, "Come into the ark, you and all your household, because I have seen that you are righteous before Me in this generation.

## **Rahab's Family Saved**

### **Joshua 2:12-13**

12 Now therefore, I beg you, swear to me by the LORD, since I have shown you kindness, that you also will show kindness to my father's house, and give me a true token, 13 and spare my father, my mother, my brothers, my sisters, and all that they have, and deliver our lives from death."

### **Zechariah 10:7-9**

7 Those of Ephraim shall be like a mighty man, and their heart shall rejoice as if with wine. Yes, their children shall see it and be glad;

Their heart shall rejoice in the LORD. 8 I will whistle for them and gather them, For I will redeem them; And they shall increase as they once increased. 9 "I will sow them among the peoples, And they shall remember Me in far countries; They shall live, together with their children, And they shall return.

"Do not think that I came to destroy the Law or the Prophets. I did not come to destroy but to fulfill. 18 For assuredly, I say to you, till heaven and earth pass away, one jot or one tittle will by no means pass from the law till all is fulfilled.

## **Hebrews 8:6**

6 But now He has obtained a more excellent ministry, inasmuch as He is also Mediator of a better covenant, which was established on better promises.

## **1. The Power of the Tongue**

### **Proverbs 18:21**

21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruit.

### **Proverbs 10:11**

11 The mouth of the righteous is a well of life, but violence covers the mouth of the wicked.

### **Proverbs 13:3**

3 He who guards his mouth preserves his life, but he who opens wide his lips shall have destruction.

### **Proverbs 15:4**

4 A wholesome tongue is a tree of life, but perverseness in it breaks the spirit.

### **James 3:2-6**

2 For we all stumble in many things. If anyone does not stumble in word,

he is a perfect man, able also to bridle the whole body. 3 Indeed, we put bits in horses' mouths that they may obey us, and we turn their whole body. 4 Look also at ships: although they are so large and are driven by fierce winds, they are turned by a very small rudder wherever the pilot desires. 5 Even so the tongue is a little member and boasts great things. See how great a forest a little fire kindles! 6 And the tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity. The tongue is so set among our members that it defiles the whole body, and sets on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire by hell.

### **Luke 6:45**

45 A good man out of the good treasure of his heart brings forth good; and an evil man out of the evil treasure of his heart brings forth evil. For out of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaks.

## **2. Jesus Christ listens to the words of our mouths**

### **Hebrews 3:1-2**

Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our confession, Christ Jesus

### **Hebrews 4:14-15**

Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.

## **3. Speak to the Mountain**

When you speak God's word against your circumstances you "draw the Sword of the Spirit which is the Word of God." (Ephesians 6:17) and you literally go into battle against your adversary, the devil with the covenant promises of God, sealed by the Blood of Jesus Christ, on your lips.

## **4. Plead the Blood over your circumstances**

**Definition:** To plead means to conduct a court case. In the court of the Universe, God is the Judge (Hebrews 12:23). Jesus is our advocate (defense attorney) (1 John 2:1,2). The devil is the prosecutor (Revelation 12:10-12). The Word of the Covenant is the law (Romans 8:2) and the

Blood of Jesus is the witness, and the witness speaks (1 John 5:7,8)

## **5. Use the Word against your Circumstances**

### **Mark 11:22-25**

22 So Jesus answered and said to them, "Have faith in God. 23 For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says. 24 Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them. 25 "And whenever you stand praying, if you have anything against anyone, forgive him, that your Father in heaven may also forgive you your trespasses.
